

Burgess Hill Transport Working Group

Proposed Terms of Reference

The role of the Working Group is to provide a framework for the Town Council to be able to critique and comment on the adequacy of highways/transport infrastructure proposals associated with the major developments affecting the Town over the period of the District Plan (ie up to 2031).

The key issue is connectivity of the various components of the town as it is developed i.e. the town centre, station interchanges, new housing developments in the east and north of the town, the new business parks, the science park and the centre for community sport/Triangle.

The main tasks of the Working Group will be:

a) To update the Transport Vision for Burgess Hill to reflect:

- i) The Town Wide Strategy
- ii) Neighbourhood Plan
- iii) District Plan
- iv) Evolving developments in Transportation

b) To use this updated Vision to review and comment on :

- I) The plans being developed by WSCC for the spending of the £6.5m. Growth Fund grant
- ii) The Road Space Audit project being undertaken by MSDC
- iii) The plans for the development of the Town Centre
- iv) The Master Plan and individual plans for the Northern Arc developments
- v) The plans for the A2300 dualing.
- vi) The plans for the Hassocks Strategic development

The Working Group will report back to the Strategic Planning and Transport Kag as appropriate.
