

BEDELANDS ADVENTURE TRAIL

This proposal would see a professionally-built tree walk and rope bridge (6ft. – 12 ft. above the ground), also a zip wire, built along the W edge of Watford Wood. Here it would be well away from the main part of Bedelands, but would be close to the BMX track and the football pitches, concentrating these young people's amenities in one area for easy access. The Friends are applying for a £40,000 grant from the Big Lottery Fund to pay for this – we were told that gathering local opinion is vital for a successful outcome. *Please complete our short questionnaire to help us get the grant!*

With the building of the Northern Arc, there will be a huge increase in the footfall on Bedelands, with some 10,000 additional residents nearby – an additional third on top of the existing 30,000 Burgess Hillians. Our beautiful local nature reserve can hardly cope with this additional pressure.
