<p>Scrapless is a community Interest Company formed in January 2020. It is a zero-waste refill store that is based upon bringing a convenient and accessible route to living more waste-free to the community. The store offers an opportunity to shop plastic- and packaging-free by using containers to fill up with goods and pay by weight rather than the brand or packaging you would typically get in the supermarket.</p> <p>Scrapless also offers cleaning product refills, fresh fruit, veg and bread supplied from local businesses, and homeware products. It provides as many local and Sussex based products as possible to encourage the community to shop locally. It also aims to educate the public on how current spending habits are harming our planet and ourselves in the process.</p> <p>The grant requested is to run free monthly workshops for the public on a variety of topics (including nutrition, cooking, health and wellbeing), as well as crafts, (including easter egg making, wreath marking, recycle can art) as well as product tastings from local producers.</p>
