Burgess Hill Town Council puts on programme of events through the Welcome Back Fund

The Welcome Back Fund is providing councils across England a share of £56 million from the European Regional Development Fund (ERDF) to support the safe return to high streets and help build back better from the pandemic. A programme of events running from November – March was approved by Burgess Hill Town Council at the Full Council Meeting on 20 September and is now being progressed.

13 November - Outdoor Escape Game


