Burgess Hill Asset List

Over the last year, Burgess Hill Town Council (BHTC) has been working with the Burgess Hill Heritage and History Association (BHHHA) to produce a Burgess Hill Assets List. Burgess Hill has a rich history, and our buildings and streets can teach us a lot, if we know where to look. The Asset List documents features throughout the town, including historical farmhouses, street furniture, terracotta moldings and more. Also included are newer assets which will be of historical value in the future.

Historian Fred Avery of BHHHA has taken the lead on compiling the list of assets, which have then been photographed by BHTC and put into a digital format. Other submissions have been received from the Worlds End Association, and Town Council staff and Councillors.
