Burgess Hill Radio supported the event by providing local live music performances in the bandstand.

There was a lively atmosphere in the town all day, with plenty of shoppers also attending the Burgess Hill Town Market.

The Town Council also worked with 8th Burgess Hill Scouts to support them running a fundraising stall for Scouts in Ukraine on 12 March. They raised a fantastic £1029 through a cake sale and raffle – well done to all of the Scouts, Leaders and parents involved.
