



Burgess Hill Town Council have made £3,000 available for emergency grants to people experiencing a fuel emergency, here in Burgess Hill.

To qualify, a family or individual will need to apply directly via the Help Point - 96 Church Walk, Burgess Hill.

Applicants must show that they have a prepayment meter, are on benefits, are a Burgess Hill resident and have an up-to-date bank statement – please call the Help Point to clarify which documents will need to be shown for validation. Applicants will then be issued with a £30 voucher to take to the Post Office to exchange for a fuel top up.

This initiative is designed to address emergencies rather than fuel poverty and only one voucher can be issued per household.
