106. OPEN FORUM

There were two members of the public present.

A local resident addressed the Committee on Item 9 of the Agenda, the Traffic Regulation Order for London Road. They informed the Committee that they had moved to Burgess Hill in 2017 and resided in a house on London Road. She stated there had been an increase in traffic over the years and that speeding was a real problem, adding that someone had recently crashed into her fence in the middle of the night due to speeding. It had been questioned previously with WSCC if a speed camera could be fitted but she was informed this was not possible, as the work load created would not be manageable by the Police service. They also stated that the road was within the Burgess Hill boundary but unlike other roads, such as Valbridge Road and Folders Lane, had not had the speed limit adjusted to 30mph. Many neighbours were also concerned and she had collected a number of signatures in support for the change in the speed limit.
