17. NOTES OF PREVIOUS MEETING

18. ALLOTMENT TENANCY AGREEMENT

The CEO reported that the agreement being considered had been drawn up after comparing our agreement with that of various other local authorities. An invitation had been extended to the stewards of the various allotment sites to submit comments and a meeting had been held with one of the stewards and an interested party which was very constructive. The agreement under consideration was the product of this work. The CEO commended Ms Hughes and Ms Dallman for the work and effort they had put into drawing up an acceptable agreement.

19. REQUEST FOR INTERVENTION: MAPLE DRIVE PAVEMENT PARKING

The group considered the options available which were to install plastic bollards, install birdmouth fencing or wooden bollards. Concern was expressed about the cost and whether the installation would be affective or just move the problem somewhere else. It was decided that a meeting be held with the Football Club to consider options and costs before a final decision is made. Cllrs Cherry and White agreed to meet with representatives of the club along with the CEO.

RECOMMENDED:

That a meeting be convened with the Football Club to discuss options to address parking on verges along Maple Drive during larger matches.
